DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE ANNOUNCES RECRUITING AND RETENTION NUMBERS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025 – THRU FEBRUARY 2025

Today, the Department of Defense (DoD) announced recruiting and retention statistics for the Active and Reserve Components through end of month February 2025.

The recruitment landscape for the Military Services remains challenging, yet the Military Services continue to make significant recruiting progress. At the end of month February 2025, all active components are successfully meeting or exceeding their recruiting goals for the fiscal year to date. The Military Services continue to prioritize resources, including recruiting personnel, as critical components in their gameplans to attract and recruit applicants needed to maintain a lethal All-Volunteer Force ready for today's missions and to confront future challenges.

• Active Component.

- Recruiting. Service data below represents cumulative goals and accessions/gains through end of month February 2025.
 - Army Accessions: Goal: 20,500; Attained 23,586 (115.05 percent/+. 3,086)
 - Navy Accessions: Goal 15,475; Attained 16,201 (104.69 percent/+726).
 - Marine Corps Accession: Goal 5,493; Attained 5,847 (106.44 percent/+354).
 - Air Force Accessions: Goal 13,328; Attained 13,329 (100.01/percent/+1).
 - Space Force Accessions: Goal 297; Attained 299 (100.67 percent/+2).
- Quality. Air Force, Marine Corps, and Space Force met or exceeded DoD quality benchmarks through end of month February 2025.
- Retention. All Services are continuing their strong efforts through the fifth month of the fiscal year, having achieved 100% or better in all zones.

• Reserve Component.

- o **Recruiting.** The data below represents the Reserve Components' cumulative goals and accessions/gains through end of month February 2025.
 - Army National Guard Gains: Goal 17,049; Attained 18,767 (110.08 percent/+1,718).
 - Army Reserve Gains: Goal 6,693; Attained 5,160 (77.10 percent/-1,533).
 - Navy Reserve Gains: Goal 3,286; Attained 3,405 (103.62 percent/+119).
 - Marine Corps Reserve Gains: Goal 2,770; Attained 3,110 (112.27 percent/+340).
 - Air National Guard Gains: Goal 3,321; Attained 3,950 (118.94 percent/+629).
 - Air Force Reserve Gains: Goal 2,536; Attained 2,642 (104.18 percent/+106).
- o **Quality.** Marine Corps Reserve, Air National Guard, and Air Force Reserve met or exceeded DoD quality benchmarks through end of month February 2025.
